Paramshila Devi is a resident of Mehnar block of Vaishali, Bihar. She belonged to a poor family as her husband was a mechanic who could barely earn Rs 200-250 per day, which seemed insufficient for taking care of their family with 3 kids. She always wanted to contribute to her family's income and to render quality education to her children.

"I came in touch with one of the loan officers of Save Microfinance in my village who was orienting people on importance of having a secondary income source and how can one apply for a loan up to Rs 30,000 for starting a micro enterprise/ small business" says Paramshila Devi.

She took a loan of Rs 25,000 and contributed rest from her family savings, for starting a medical store. With her hard work and dedication now she, along with her husband, earns Rs 400-500 a day by this shop. A portion of this income she returns back to SAVE as monthly repayment towards the loan and rest she saves for well-being of her family.
