Mr Porkhit Rabhawas is a resident of West Garo Hills, Meghalaya.

“Earlier, I used to work as a daily wage labourer with a private construction company in Guwahati. Even after doing hard work of 10-12 hours a day, I was unable to save much for the future. I came in contact with Mr Samrath Rabha, a CSP in-charge of SAVE Solutions who told me about the work of corporate business correspondent of SBI. I was required to open villagers’ bank account by visiting their homes under PMJDY Scheme. I partnered with SAVE and started working as a BC. Now I could easily save Rs 1200-1500 per month after incurring my household expenses. Moreover, I can stay with my family in my village.”

The journey of Mr Porkhit doesn’t stop here. Within a year he accumulated sufficient corpus of to start a small grocery shop in his area while continuing with his business correspondent role.
