



SUCCESS STORY OF SRI SAGAR MUKUND KAMBLE

-A journey from struggle to success

Sagar Mukund Kambale is a resident of Indira Nagar Ahmednagar, Maharashtra. His main source of livelihood was selling roasted grams & peanuts as a hawker. He was able to earn mere ₹150 to ₹200 per day which seemed insufficient even in fulfilling basic necessities for his family. He always wished for a proper brick and mortar shop for selling peanuts, grams & snacks, as he believed that such a business had a great potential, but the lack of availability of funds had always been the challenge.

He came in touch with one of the loan officers of **SAVE** having KoID 1A741495 located in Bhinger, Ahmednagar, organized an a/c opening camp under PMJDY through which he created awareness of having a savings a/c amongst all local villagers. Mr. Sagar Kamble also being on of the participant of the camp, understood the benefits of having a bank a/c & he immediately placed a request for the savings bank account at Bhinger CSP. He managed to start with a small savings of ₹40-₹50 per day and on the



basis of this transaction trend of his account, he was able to get Mudra Loan sanctioned amounting to ₹50,000/- for his business & he started selling peanuts, grams & snacks by taking a shop on rent and he started flourishing his business.

After a year, the bank again sanctioned him a Mudra Loan of ₹3 lakhs through which he was further able to expand his business. Now he is happy and enjoys a better standard of living & a peaceful life with his family.
